

## Lead under REACH - what could it mean for leaded copper alloys?

The REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals) regulation entered into force on 1 June 2007 and applies to all chemical substances and therefore impacts most companies across the EU. To comply with the regulation, companies must identify and manage the risks linked to the substances they manufacture and market in the EU.

In the case of leaded copper alloys, various aspects must be considered by product manufacturers:

- How do I inform my customers?
- Are there any technological effects on products?
- Are there additional requirements when importing products from outside the EU?
- What are the legal requirements for bringing leaded copper alloys onto the market?
- Who has to do what along the supply chain?

This event provides a condensed overview of the REACH requirements for leaded copper alloys and is aimed at product manufacturers and distributors.

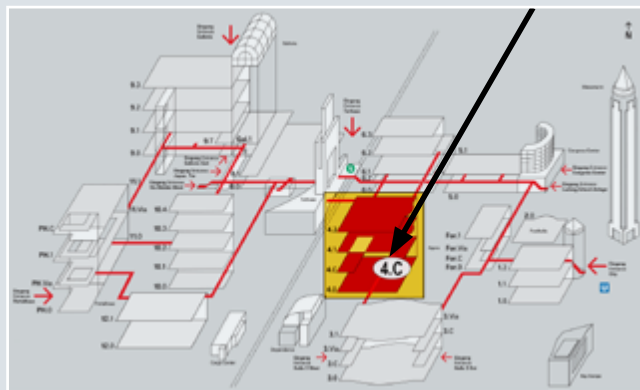
